

## 2012 T.S.C.A.R. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Applicant must:

1. Be a member in good standing of the Tennessee Society Children of the American Revolution for at least three years. Applicant must also be a member in good standing of the National Society Children of the American Revolution.
2. Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale. If another grading scale is used, please submit that information.
3. Be enrolled as a full- time student (high school senior or 12 college hours) and maintain full-time status for each semester the scholarship is awarded.
4. Complete application form obtained from the Scholarship Chairman or the applicant's Senior Society President.
5. May reapply every year.
6. Submit a typed essay of 400-500 words on the topic: **How has my C.A.R. involvement prepared me for the future.**
7. Submit three letters of recommendation  
Examples:      Local Senior Society President  
                         Teacher, Principal, Counselor  
                         Scout Leader, Coach, Minister
8. Submit copy of school transcript
9. Send completed application and all required documentation to each of the scholarship committee members listed below by February 28, 2012

The Scholarship Committee is composed of the Scholarship Chairman (appointed by the state president), the state president, and two seniors appointed by the senior state president.

The scholarship does not have to be awarded. Decision of the committee is final.  
The committee will recommend to the senior state board the amount of the scholarship and whether to award more than one scholarship.
